Wednesday from 3:30-5:30 pm.**

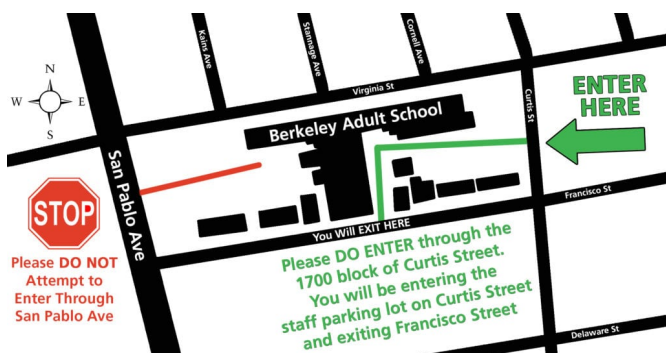
Students and families can come to the Ed Hub for:

The Ed Hub is located at the Berkeley Adult School (BAS) staff parking lot at the **1700 block of Curtis Street**. Please note, you will be entering the staff parking lot on Curtis Street and exiting Francisco Street, see the map below. You can drive-thru and will not need to get out of your car. Delivery is available for families that can't get to the Hub during scheduled hours.
